The Great Commission-Discipleship Jesus died on the cross and resurrected to produce more sons for the Father. He left us with His word, the ministry of reconciliation In Matthew 28:19-20, Jesus gives an instruction which is known as the GREAT COMMISSION. Prior to this, He asserted that "ALL





A centurion wanted Jesus to heal his servant. Jesus told him "I will come and heal him" and his response to Jesus was: "...Only speak a word and my servant will be healed." He said this based on the premise that he was a man UNDER AUTHORITY, with soldiers under him. He says to one, "GO" and he goes... (Matthew 8:6-9). Jesus spoke a word and the centurion's servant was healed. This man understood authority.



Imagine this: (A conversation between Jesus and a centurion)



Back to Matthew 28:19-20, this Jesus has ALL AUTHORITY given to him not just in heaven but on earth. This is the description of the person who gave his disciples the great commission. The great commission is a mandate to every believer/disciple.

¹⁸ And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ Go [c]therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and Io, I am with you always, even to the end of the age."



Let's break down the theme scripture: Matthew 28:18-20,



A) GO - It means to go, to travel, to journey
B) MAKE DISCIPLES OF ALL NATIONS - It means helping someone to
PROGRESSIVELY learn the word of God to BECOME matured growing
disciples of Jesus Christ in BELIEF and PRACTICE. It also means to
teach and train people to follow and obey God. A disciple in this
context is a follower of Jesus Christ, the Master.



Let's break down the theme scripture: Matthew 28:18-20,



When Jesus called Peter and Andrew to be His disciples, He told them, "Follow me and I will MAKE YOU fishers of men." They **IMMEDIATELY left their nets and followed Jesus.** They moved from being professional fishermen to anointed fishers of men lol. Discipleship is about responding and moving from where you are to where God wants you to be. That's why Paul said in I Corinthians 11:1, Imitate me as I imitate Christ. In discipleship, Jesus Christ is the standard.

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Imagine this: The simplest way to start participating in the fulfillment of this mandate is by impacting the lives of the people closest to you both in proximity and in relation. **C) BAPTIZING THEM IN THE NAME OF THE FATHER, THE SON AND THE** HOLY SPIRIT- As a disciple, you do not go in your authority but in the authority of the Godhead.






Imagine this: Baptism of repentance (Mark 1:8, Acts 19:1-7) John baptized with water which signified repentance. That's the first step to becoming a disciple of Christ-Repenting, believing ,and accepting Him as your Lord and Personal savior. In Acts 19:1-7, Paul asked some disciples in Ephesus "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?"... Then when he laid his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came upon them and they spoke with tongues and prophesied.


